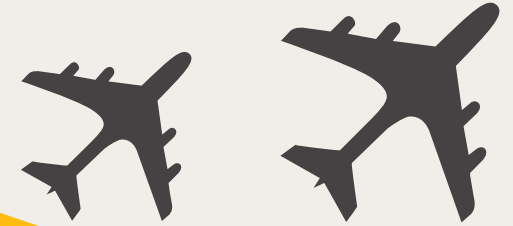
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- File a FAFSA or CADAA by the March 2nd priority deadline
- Submit additional documents requested from financial aid

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- Campus EAP shares a list of Participants
- UCEAP shares EAP Program Cost
- Students are awarded financial aid 3-4 weeks prior to their program start date
- IF APPLICABLE: Students complete the Loan Acceptance Process
- Financial Aid is reported to UCEAP
- Students see their Financial Aid on the MyEAP account
